Description:

This course introduces students to the fundamentals of Sindhi language, culture, and folk heritage. Sindhi is an Indo-Aryan language with traces back to the 10th century—one of the foremost languages of South Asia to encounter the influence Persian and Arabic. Sindhi provides an enriching literary tradition with the likes of Shah Abdul Latif's and Sacchal Sarmast's mystical poetry.

It's an elementary level course that covers four basic skills: reading, writing, listening, and speaking. The main topics include basic expressions used in everyday life, such as greetings, introducing yourself, talking about your family and daily life and so on. Each lesson covers grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, dialogues, and role-plays. The selection of reading materials and class activities are designed to make the content as rich and varied as possible.
