Khadija Bakhtiar Founder & CEO Teach For Pakistan

Khadija Shahper Bakhtiar is the Chief Executive Officer and Founder of Teach For Pakistan, which nurtures leadership to end educational inequity. Teach For Pakistan provides inspired university graduates the opportunity and support to teach for two years in low-income communities through a structured Fellowship program, and develop the leadership skills and contextual understandings to affect long-term, system-wide reform for educational equity. Khadija led the Teach For Pakistan pilot, recruiting, developing and graduating 100+ exceptional leaders who are working nationwide to accelerate systemic change for equity and excellence in education. In 2017, Teach For Pakistan was launched as an independent organization and currently has 183 Alumni leaders, and 155 Fellows teaching 10,500+ students across high-need public schools in marginalized rural communities on the outskirts of Islamabad. Khadija is a Fulbright Scholar with a Master of Public Policy from University of California, Berkeley and a BSc. (hon) in Social Sciences from the Lahore University of Management Sciences (LUMS), which recognized her efforts with Teach For Pakistan through the 2019 Vice Chancellor's Alumni Achievement Award.
